

Hearing and Balance Center

The IHC Hearing & Balance Center is a unique and valuable resource where both vestibular diagnostics (audiology) and vestibular rehabilitation (physical therapy) occur in the same clinic with staff members who closely coordinate patient care. During the R2-5 years, residents should plan to visit the Hearing & Balance Center for training under the director and his staff. These requirements must be completed before January 1 of PGY5.

1. Call 801-585-1700 to schedule an appointment with the Director of the Hearing and Balance Center or his/her designee that will consist of the following:
 - a. Review requirements of residency training
 - b. Instruction in ENG/VNG interpretation
 - a. Instruction in Computerized Dynamic Posturography interpretation
 - b. Instruction in Rotary Chair interpretation
 - c. Review of clinic produced case studies (power point and/or binder) and “*Vestibular Disorders*” text.
2. Review of VNG pitfalls power point.
3. Review the Evoked Potential PowerPoint presentation consisting of ECochG, ABR, AOE, VEMP and ENOG
4. Observe a minimum of three vestibular evaluations and discuss afterwards with audiologist
5. Observe a minimum of one vestibular rehabilitation evaluation and discuss afterwards with audiologist

The resident training record will be maintained by the Director of the Hearing and Balance and reviewed at the start of the PGY5 to identify any incomplete requirements to ensure the course of study has been completed by December 31st.
